Piedy Sailing Dates(draft)

 This day is to teach parents how to rig all the boats, get people signed off on how to drive RIBS, the quad, use VHF5 etc
 It is a hands on introduction to sailing at the club involving racing RS Fevas in a regatta like format. This is similar to the the Jones Memorial Regatta held last year.
 We want to make sure parents know what they are in for, and gain some sailing club experience for themselves before the kids get their turn.
